What a wonderful gift and opportunity that we have during this Easter season to share with everyone the good news of salvation. There seem to be a good many of us Catholics who do not regularly take advantage of God's incredible mercy. How do we rekindle the hearts of lukewarm Catholics and urge them to be faithful again and to receive pardon for their sins?

There is a way that can be used to melt hardened hearts and to bring them into full communion with the Church. Divine Mercy Sunday offers us a wonderful opportunity to bring this to fruition.

How about if everyone was offered something very special - something so special that no one would be able to refuse? The Plenary Indulgence for Divine Mercy Sunday that the Church issued could be just the enticement.

The official Vatican explanation of the Feast of Mercy is as follows: According to Jesus, the Feast of Mercy is to be celebrated on the first Sunday after Easter (Second Sunday of Easter). The Feast of Mercy is to be not only a day designated for the worship of God's mercy, **but also a day of grace for all people, particularly** for sinners. Jesus attached great promises to this feast. One is the promise of complete forgiveness of sins and punishment. In other words, this grace is equal to the one we receive in the sacrament of baptism. It offers a completely new beginning. The image is to be blessed and venerated on Divine Mercy Sunday.

Blessings to our entire faith community. As Jesus's resurrection is once again a reminder to each of us of who and why we believe, may we also become a new creation, and be renewed in faith, hope, love and service to God and each other.

Put aside all those things that separate us from God and commit ourselves to becoming that Hosanna people, that Alleluia people, the people with Easter always in our minds, on our lips and in our hearts - the people that we are all called and invited to be!

Please remember to pray for the repose of the soul of Pope Francis. A prayer of gratitude for all that he has given our Church; and a prayer that the Holy spirit will guide the minds and hearts of the College of Cardinals as they decide who best to guide the Church of Christ in the years to come.

As usual please remember to pray for all the Salesians in our presence here at MHC . . . especially those at St. Philip Residence. Be assured we will be doing the same for you.

Francis de Sales, (French: François de Sales; Italian: Francesco di Sales; 21 August 1567 – 28 December 1922 was a Savoyard Catholic prelate who served as <u>Bishop of Geneva</u> and is a <u>saint</u> of the <u>Catholic</u> <u>Church</u>. He became noted for his deep <u>faith</u> and his gentle approach to the religious divisions in his land resulting from the Protestant <u>Reformation</u>. He is known also for his writings on the topic of <u>spiritual direction</u> and spiritual formation, particularly the <u>Introduction to the Devout Life</u> and the <u>Treatise</u> on the Love of <u>God</u>. **Beatified** 8 January 1661, Rome, Papal States, by Pope Alex-



ander VII. **Canonized** 8 April 1665, Rome, Papal States, by Pope Alexander VII. Feast Day 24 January 1969. **Attributes**-Heart of Jesus, Crown of Thorns. The <u>religious institute</u> of the <u>Salesians of Don Bosco</u>, founded by John Bosco in 1859 (approved by the <u>Holy See</u> in 1874), is also known as the Society of Saint Francis de Sales, and is placed under his patronage.


