Dear People of God,

Today's feat of Divine Mercy reminds us that authority exercises power not only by judging, condemning and sentencing, but also by granting mercy.

When the priest's voice tells the penitent, "I absolve you from all of your sins in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit," guilt evaporates into thin air. The purest form and expression of power is the granting of mercy.

Mercy does not turn a blind eye to justice but fulfills its obligations to justice by going beyond them. After all, one cannot be absolved of having done nothing. Likewise, where there is no guilt, there is no need of mercy.

Because God is the seat of all authority, He is also the seat of all mercy.

St. Pope John Paul II first inserted this feast of Divine Mercy into the Roman Calendar on April 30, 2000, the canonization day of St. Faustina. St. Pope John Paul II was also canonized on Divine Mercy Sunday in 2014.

And so, the Church's third millennium was launched with a new devotion, a new piety rooted in the most ancient truths. Divine Mercy is the new face of God for this third millennium. This is the God who waits for us with bated breath to acknowledge in the privacy of the confessional, "Forgive me Father for I have sinned." This is the God who, at the end of time, whether our time or all time, waits to hear from each of us those few prized words, "Lord, have mercy." Having received that, we need not receive anything more.

Laura del Carmen Vicuña Pino (5 April, 1891 – 22 January, 1904) was a <u>Chilean</u> child who was noted for her religious devotion. She was <u>beatified</u> by Pope John Paul II in 1988 as the patron of abuse victims¹, having herself

experienced physical abuse. Laura entered the Hijas de Maria Auxiliadora (<u>"Daughters of Mary Help of Christians</u>") School, where, under the care of the nuns, she began to take a deep interest in the Catholic faith.^[4]

During one of her school vacations, Laura was beaten twice by Manuel Mora, who wanted her to forget about becoming a nun.

The Laura Vicuña Women Development and Training Center in Victorias City, Negros Occidental was named after her and is managed by the Daughters of Mary Help of Christians. Another concrete statue of Laura

stands near the entrance gate of the school.
