Blessed Augustus Czartoryski, In July 1887, after having renounced his earthly goods and all possibility of the throne, he entered the novitiate against his family's wishes. He was 29 years of age. In his efforts to adapt himself to the Oratory and its lifestyle, he became the humblest of novices. Don Bosco, almost on his deathbed, blessed his religious habit. He began his

> philosophy studies. He soon took ill with tuberculosis. In the house at Valsalice, Turin. Augustus fully took on Salesian spirituality, especially its element of sacrifice and offered his life and sufferings for the good of the young and the Congregation just as Don Bosco did. Fr. Augustus died in Alassio on April 8, 1893, on the Saturday of the Octave of Easter. He was 35 years old. St. John Paul II, the Polish Pope, had the joy of declaring him Blessed on April 25, 2004. His body is venerated in Przemysl (Poland).
