On the Third, Fourth and Fifth Sundays of Lent, the readings from Year A are connected with the celebration of the Scrutinies prayers for purification and strength - for the elect who will be baptized at the Easter Vigil.

In the gospel today we see Jesus overturn the traditional understanding of blindness as a punishment for immorality found in the Mosaic Law.

The story of the blind man whom Jesus heals is interesting on many fronts, one of which is the fact that this man does not seem to have a name. He is simply referred to as the "man blind from birth." This is significant in the Gospel of John because the lack of a name is also seen, for example, in the story of "the woman at the well." The fact that there is no Name seems to indicate that we should see ourselves in this story.

How He heals this man is also significant. Using His own spit on this man's eyes, which does not at first reading seem all that appealing. It does reveal, however, the fact that Jesus can use something exceptionally ordinary as a source of His divine grace. If we allow Jesus to give us all the gift of spiritual sight, we will be amazed at the beauty we all will behold.

Please consider joining us on for an overnight of Adoration before Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament here at MHC Church. The adoration service begins @ 5:00pm on Friday, March 15th and closes before our Vigil Mass on Saturday, March 16th.

As usual please remember to pray for all the Salesians in our presence here at MHC . . . especially those at St. Philip Residence. Be assured we will be doing the same for you.

Titus Zeman (4 January 1915 – 8 January 1969) was a Slovak Roman Catholic priest and a professed member of the Salesians of Don Bosco.

<sup>1</sup> Zeman studied in Italian cities prior to his ordination and worked in Slovakia to protect fellow Salesians after the communist regime outlawed religious orders.<sup>[2]</sup> He was arrested after attempting to send Salesians out of the nation and was imprisoned from 1952 until 1964 and died due to poor health sustained from the prison conditions. He has been acclaimed as a defender of religious liberties.

Zeman was acclaimed a Servant of God in 2010 under Pope Benedict XVI after the canonization process commenced in Bratislava – the cause was taken with ascertaining whether Zeman had died Lily for a loved one either de-"in odium fidei" (in hatred of the faith).<sup>[4]</sup> Pope rancis approved his beatification on 27 February 2017; the beatification occurred in Bratislava on

30 September 2017.
