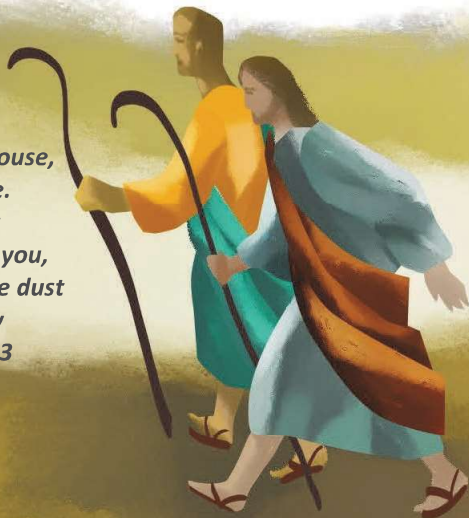

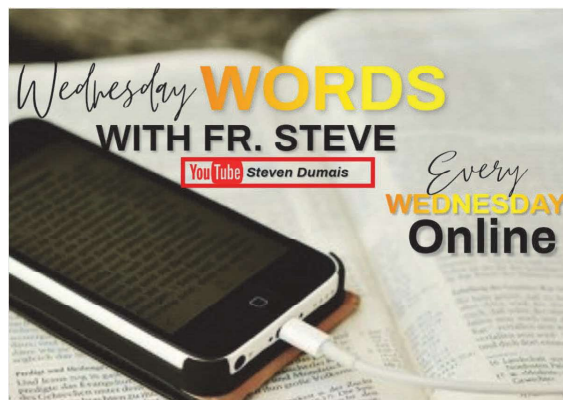
Camp Mary Help has availability for July! Register online before it fills up!
