Dear People of God,

While his calendar feast is on January 31<sup>st</sup>, the day of his death in 1888, we celebrate St. John Bosco as a Salesian presence today, Sunday, February 4, 2024. We are proud of being a part of that large movement of people that he launched 183 years ago. As members of that great movement, we want to help every young person on the face of the earth go to Jesus - to have fullness of life!

Don Bosco was a wonderful confessor. He never let tiredness interfere with the hearing of a confession, especially one of his boys. He said on one occasion, "some birds, you know, can only be caught on the wing. Once you let them go you may never catch them again."

One day in the Christmas Octave, after hearing confessions for hours, and having offered midnight Mass, Don Bosco was utterly worn out, when five or six of his Sunday boys arrived and asked him to hear their confessions. He heard the confessions of the first two and fell asleep on the shoulder of the third. The first two went away on tip-toe. The three who were waiting sat down very quietly, and the sixth knelt down motionless by Don Bosco. Fifteen minutes later Don Bosco awoke. "My poor little fellow," he groaned, "how long have you been waiting? Why, on earth, did you not awaken me?" "It would have been a sin, Father," they said, "you were so tired and were sleeping so soundly." "I'll never have such a chance again," said one of the little penitents proudly, "his head was on my shoulder all the time."

May all of us see in Don Bosco someone who exemplifies the model of kindness, charity, and compassion that the gospel challenges and invites us to emulate ourselves. We all have been given countless chances to make a positive difference in someone's life. It doesn't take much. Don't just think about it. Do it! . . . not just once, but regularly, often, every day.

#### WHO IS DON BOSCO



John Bosco, also known as Giovanni Melchiorre Bosco and Don Bosco, was born in Becchi, Italy, on August 16, 1815. His birth came just after the end of the Napoleonic Wars which ravaged the area. Compounding the problems on his birthday, there was also a drought and a famine at the time of his birth. He founded the Salesian order, which is dedicated to the education and welfare of young people 1. St. John Bosco is a patron saint of editors, publishers, youth, apprentices, and magicians 1. He was canonized by the Catholic Church on April 1, 1934, and his feast day is celebrated on January 31


