WHO IS DON BOSCO

Iohn Melchior Bosco, SDB, popularly known as Don Bosco, was an Italian Catholic priest, educator, writer and saint of the 19th century. While working in Turin, where the population suffered many of the ill-effects of industrialization and urbanization, he dedicated his life to the betterment and education of street children, juvenile delinquents, and other disadvantaged youth. He devel oped teaching methods based on love rather than punishment, a method that became known as the Salesian Preventive System.


