Dear People of God

In his "Motu Proprio" of September 30, 2019, Pope Francis declared that "the Third Sunday in Ordinary Time is to be devoted to the celebration, study, and dissemination of the word of God. This Sunday of the Word of God will thus be a fitting part of that time of year when we are encouraged to strengthen our bonds with the Jewish people and to pray for Christian unity . . . [We] urgently need to grow in our knowledge and love of the Scriptures and of the risen lord, who continues to speak his word and to break bread in the community of believers."

January 24th is the annual Feast day of St. Francis De Sales. St. John Bosco chose him as a model for the Salesians of Don Bosco and we are named in his honor. Francis was born into the noble family of the Duchy of Savoy in the Chateau De Sales on August 21, 1567. He was the first of six children and enjoyed a privileged education at the best schools possible. His spiritual education was entrusted to the Jesuits. In 1592, Francis ended his studies with the title of "Doctor", certified in both law and theology. He chose the priesthood over an arranged marriage and a military career chosen for him by his father. This was a difficult choice for his father to accept.

In 1602 Francis was consecrated Bishop of Geneva in Switzerland, which was a hotbed of Calvinist control. He acquired a reputation as a spellbinding preacher. He was known as a friend of the poor, and a man of almost supernatural kindness and understanding. In his "Introduction to the Devout Life" he counseled charity over penance as a means of progressing in the spiritual life.

We Salesians of St. John Bosco are proud to have St. Francis as our namesake and model. As we prepare to celebrate the Feast of St. John Bosco Wednesday, January 31st, (and officially on February 4th at the 10:00am Mass in the gymnasium), may we all prepare to draw closer to Christ through continued random acts of kindness and charity to and for others.

In this week of Prayer for Christian Unity, prayer for the Legal Protection of the Unborn, let's also remember to pray for UNITY and PEACE in the world, in and for our country and in and for our own families.

As usual please remember to pray for all of the Salesians in our presence here at MHC . . . especially those at St. Philip Residence. Be assured we will be doing the same for you.

WHO IS DON BOSCO

John Melchior Bosco, SDB, popularly known as Don Bosco, was an Italian Catholic priest, educator, writer and saint of the 19th century. While working in Turin, where the population suffered many of the ill-effects of industrialization and urbanization, he dedicated his life to the betterment and education of street children, juvenile delinquents, and other disadvantaged youth. He developed teaching methods based on love rather than punishment, a method that became known as the Salesian Preventive System.




