On this Second Sunday of Advent, we are given the person of St. John the Baptist to consider. What a gift he is! Jesus Himself stated that "among those born of women there has been none greater than John the Baptist". What a compliment!

What is it that made John so great? We can point to two special things. The first has to do with his calling and the second has to do with his virtue.

First, John was great because he was the transition from the Old Testament Prophets to the New Testament. He was the bridge that prepared everyone for the new life to come. His unique mission makes him truly great.

But John was great not only because of his unique calling, he was also great because of the virtue he had in his life. And this gift is what we are called to reflect on at this time. John's particular virtue was that of humility.

He saw himself as nothing more than a "voice of one crying out in the desert." And the Word he spoke was Jesus.

Reflect today, upon this humility in your own life. Do you tend to point to yourself or to Christ? Do you seek the praise of others or do you humbly point all praise and glory to God? Humility is the path that John the Baptist chose and it is the path we must also strive for each and every day.

BL.PHILIP RINALDI -Born on May 28, 1856 at Lu Monferrato (Alessandria), Philip was won over by Don Bosco at the age of twenty-two. As a priest, he was entrusted with the formation of the aspirants and novices. In 1899 Fr. Rua sent him as Director of the community of Sarriá, Spain and later as provincial leader. In this role he contributed greatly to the development of Salesian Spain. Nominated Vicar General of the Congregation, his gifts as father and the wealth of his initiatives became even more evident. He set up formation centres to offer spiritual and social assistance

to young working women, planned printing works and guided and supported the Salesian Sisters through a particularly sensitive period in their history. He gave great encouragement to the Cooperators, and set up the World Federations of Past-Pupils (male and female). He was elected Rector Major in 1922. "All that is lacking to Fr. Rinaldi is Don Bosco's voice: he has everything else" said Fr. Francesia.


