On this Second Sunday of Advent, we are given the person of St. John the Baptis' to consider. What a gift he is! Jesus Himself stated that "among those born of women there has been none greater than John the Baptist". What a compliment!

What is it that made John so great? We can point to two things in particular. The first has to do with his calling and the second has to do with his virtue.

First of all, John was great because he was the transition from the Old Testament Prophets to the New Testament. He was the bridge that prepared for the new life to come. His unique mission makes him truly great.

But John was great not only because of his unique calling, he was also great because of the virtue he had in his life. And this gift is what we are called to reflect on at this time. John's particular virtue was that of humility.

He saw himself as nothing more than a "voice of one crying out in the desert." And the Word he spoke was Jesus.

Reflect today, upon this humility in you own life. Do you tend to point to yourself or to Christ? Do you seek the praise of others or do you humbly point all praise and glory to God? Humility is the path that John the Baptist chose and it is the path we must also strive for each and every day.

Margherita Occhiena was born on 1 April 1788 in Capriglio in Asti, the sixth of ten children. At the age of 24 she married 27 year old Francesco Bosco, a family friend and widower whose wife and infant daughter had died shortly after childbirth, leaving him with a three-year-old son, Anthony. The family settled in Becchi, a hamlet of Castelnuovo d'Asti (today Castelnuovo Don Bosco). Francesco died of pneumonia in May 1817, leaving the 29-year-old Margherita



a single mother with three sons: Antonio, Giuseppe and Giovanni (John). [1] A strong woman with clear ideas, Occhiena raised her sons with a regimen of sober living, strict but reasonable. The boys were quite different in temperament. Still, Occhiena made sure she presented them with the beginnings of a Christian education. She gave them the example of faith, wisdom, and courage in facing the difficulties of life [1]
