Dear People of God,

Once again, on this third Sunday of Advent, we are given the wonderful testimony and witness of John the Baptist.

John's guestion, "Are you the one who is to come, or should we look for another?", is really the question for people of every age. More clearly than most places in the gospel, the writer places the question smackdab in our own laps. What will we make of this Jesus? Is he indeed the Messiah? For us? If not, how will we be opened to hear and see him as Messiah in such a way that he becomes the very reality of God's blessing in our lives.

If this Jesus is really the good news of God, then why is there still so much suffering and pain, evil and destruction, or hurt and brokenness among God's creation? The answers lie in the follow-up question of Jesus. What do we expect to see in this Messiah? And what will we make of him?

If we are to receive this Jesus as God's Messiah "for us," then it will call for a dramatic shift and change in how we hear and what we see, and the choices and decisions we make each day of our lives.

If we are to answer "Yes" to John's exhortations, we are first called to experience what Luke means by living "the good news". It calls us to truly experience the Advent expectation and its promise to transform our vision and our hope.

Margherita Occhiena was born on 1 April 1788 in Capriglio in Asti, the sixth of ten children. At the age of 24 she married 27 year old Francesco Bosco, a family friend and widower whose wife and infant daughter had died shortly after childbirth, leaving him with a threeyear-old son, Anthony. The family settled in Becchi, a hamlet of Castelnuovo d'Asti (today Castelnuovo Don Bosco). Francesco died of pneumonia in May 1817, leaving the 29-year-old Margherita

a single mother with three sons: Antonio, Giuseppe and Giovanni (John). [1] A strong woman with clear ideas, Occhiena raised her sons with a regimen of sober living, strict but reasonable. The boys were quite different in temperament. Still, Occhiena made sure she presented them with the beginnings of a Christian education. She gave them the example of faith, wisdom, and courage in facing the difficulties


