María Romero Meneses, FMA (13 January 1902 – 7 July 1977) was a <u>Nicaraguan Catholic religious sister</u> and a professed member from the <u>Salesian Sisters of Don Bosco</u> dubbed the "Social Apostle of Costa Rica". María Romero Meneses was born in <u>Nicaragua</u> in 1902 as one of eight children to middle-class parents – her father was a government minister. Her parents were Félix Romero Arana and Ana Meneses Blandón. Her <u>baptism</u> was held on January the



20th. She received her Confirmation on July 23, 1904, from Siméon Pereira y Castellón and received her First Communion on December 8, 1909. The hopeful girl joined the Marian association Daughters of Mary Help of Christians on December 8, 1915, to follow her Marian call. In 1920 she joined that congregation and left for El Salvador for her period of novitiate, receiving the habit of the order on January 16, 1921. On 6 January 1929 in Nicaragua she made her final profession.
