Blessed Stephen Sandor, SDB: Stephen was born on November 26, 1914 in Szolnok, Hungary. By reading the Salesian Bulletin, he came to know about Don Bosco and was attracted by the Salesian charism. In 1936, he was accepted at the Clarisseum as an aspirant and while there he became a printer at the Don Bosco Printery. In 1939, he entered the novitiate and made his first vows on September 8, 1940 as a Salesian Brother and his perpetual vows on July 24, 1946. In 1948, he gained the title of Master Printer. He taught in the schools until the persecution of Catholic schools began, and the schools were forced to close. In July 1952, he was arrested and nothing was known of his whereabouts until the fall of the Berlin Wall. It was then learned he had been brutally tortured, falsely tried in court, found guilty for treason against Hungary, sentenced to death, and was hanged



on June 8, 1953. Only after 1990 was it demonstrated that he had died "a martyr of the faith". The site of his burial remains unknown. .
