Dear People of God,

I often wonder who the "many" are that Jesus speaks of that will come in His name. Are they in our midst today?

First, Jesus tells us that there will be many false prophets who will have the ability to deceive. They will portray themselves as messengers of the truth and dispensers of the will of God. Their words will be convincing and many will follow.

When we are living in a state of true prayer and when someone speaks a false and deceiving message, something will not sit right with us. There will be a sense in the depths of our souls that something is not right.

Reflect, today, on whether or not you seek out and hear God speaking to you in the depths of your conscience. Learn His voice and seek to hear Him speak through other people. No matter what you hear, you should always remain faithful to God speaking within you. It is there more than any other place that He will lead you. Maddalena Caterina Morano was born in Chieri, in the province of Turin, on the November 15, 1847. Her father Francis died when she was eight and she began to help her mother with her work. Thanks to her uncle, a priest, she was able to resume her studies. Her teacher appointed her to help the little ones. Meanwhile she met Don Bosco for the first time, while walking to Buttigliera d'Asti. Maddalena wanted to teach, and when she was 17, she gained her teacher's certificate. She immediately began teaching. In 1880, she consecrated herself to God through perpetual vows, and asked the Lord for the grace "of

staying alive until she had become a saint." In 1881, at the request of the archbishop of Catania, Maddalena was invited to direct the new work at Trecastagni, where three teachers were working. For four years, she was in charge, taught, washed, cooked, was catechist but was especially a witness to the point where the girls were always calling, asking: we want to be like
