I recently read about a woman who left instructions for her children that when she died, they should place on her grave a parking meter that read: "Time Expired." She must have had a pretty decent sense

As we rapidly approach the end of the liturgical year, "Time Expired" can also be used as the theme of today's liturgy. Shortly after Advent and Christmas, we will see the end of the calendar year of 2024 and begin a new calendar year. In the gospel today, Jesus describes the end of this world as we know it.

We don't like to think about everything expiring and the end of all things. Jesus reminds us because he knows that only those who know how to love in this life will be able to participate in the new creation that is built on love.

He again reminds us that the choices we make in this life will determine what is ahead for us in the future. Many in our culture today, believe that somehow everyone will end up happy in God's kingdom. This sounds nice, however, if this were true why would Jesus have gone through so much in order to tell us it is important how we live life now?

The last thing Jesus tells us in today's gospel is that no one, not even Jesus, knows when all this will take place, or when he will return again to initiate the reign of God and his eternal kingdom.

Not knowing when all these things may happen is not meant to frighten anyone, unless they need to be frightened into living a good life, but it should motivate us to be prepared...It should give us hope during any type of trial that our time and trial "now" is temporary, but "eternity" is forever.

Blessed Michael Rua first successor of Don Bosco.

Born in Turin on June 9, 1837, the youngest of nine children, Michael came to the Oratory in 1852. One day, Don Bosco told him: "We will go halves in As usual please remember to pray for all of the Salesians in our presthe formation of the Salesian Society.

At the explicit request of the Founder, in 1884, Pope Leo XIII named him to



succeed Don Bosco and confirmed him as Rector Major in 1888. Fr. Michael was seen as the 'Living Rule' because of his austere fidelity, yet he also displayed a fatherly spirit that was capable of great thoughtfulness, so much so that he was known as 'a king of kindness.' When beatifying him, Pope Paul VI stated: "The Salesian Family owes its origin to Don Bosco and, to Fr. Michael, its continuation...he developed the Saint's example into a school, his Rule into a spirit, his holiness into a model. He turned the spring into a river." His remains are venerated in the crypt of the Basilica of Mary Our Help.


