The season of Advent is a time of joyful expectation. The Lord is coming! Wake up! Get ready! We probably cannot hope to be as excited as this little boy, but the church puts us in touch with the eagerness of the early Christians at Rome.

The Romans who first read Paul's letter were only a few years removed from Jesus' ascension and were expecting him to return in glory any day.

"... For our salvation is nearer now than when we first believed." The church had to deal with some extremes. Why work if the end is near? With the passage of years, the church realized that it might be a long time before Jesus came a second time. That brought other problems. The delay could make us forget or become complacent about his coming.

That is where we are today. The First Sunday of Advent comes as a surprise in the humdrum of our daily lives. We are running around as usual, from one task to the next, one busy day to the next, when suddenly here it is again. What? Is it that time of the year again?

The Church encourages us to slow down, to refocus, to wait for the coming of the Lord in quiet hope. The idea of the Lord's coming has expanded since the time of the Romans. We still look forward to his coming in glory at the end of time, but we concentrate more now on preparing ourselves for his present coming in grace and we look back to his first coming, the incarnation, to understand what it means for us.

Margherita Occhiena was born on April 1, 1788 at Capriglio, in the province of Asti, sixth of ten children. She was baptized on the same day in the parish church. Her parents were peasant farmers full of good Christian attitudes and practices. From when she was just a child Margaret was a great worker. She had no opportunity for schooling because of the times she lived in and the tasks she had to do, but her love for prayer gave her a wisdom which could not be gained from books. in 1812, she married Francis Bosco. Francis was 27 years of age, a widower, with a three year old child, Anthony, and a sick mother to look after. Joseph was born the fol-



lowing year and in 1815, John (the future Don Bosco). They moved to the Becchi, a hamlet of Castelnuovo d'Asti. In 1817 Francis died of pneumonia. Twenty-nine year old Margaret found herself running the family alone at a time of famine, looking after Francis' mother, Anthony, and young Joseph and John. Margaret was a woman of great faith. God was foremost in her thoughts and always on her lips.


