Giovanni di Pietro di Bernardone (c. 1181 – 3 October 1226), known as **Francis of Assisi**, was an <u>Italian mystic</u>, poet and <u>Catholic friar</u> who founded the religious order of the <u>Franciscans</u>. Inspired to lead a <u>Christian</u> life of poverty, he became a <u>beggar</u> and an <u>itinerant preacher</u>. One of the most venerated figures in Christianity, Francis was <u>canonized</u> by <u>Pope Gregory IX</u> on 16 July 1228. He is commonly portrayed wearing a

brown habit with a rope tied around his waist, featuring three knots symbolizing the evangelical counsels of poverty, chastity, and obedience. Francis is associated with patronage of animals and the environment. It became customary for churches to hold ceremonies blessing animals on his feast day of 4 October, which became World Animal Day.
