Zepherin Namuncurá He was born at Chimpay, a small town in Valle Medio, <u>Río Negro Province</u>, <u>Argentina</u>,<sup>[1]</sup> the sixth child of Rosario Burgos and a Mapuche cacique, Manuel Namuncurá.<sup>[2]</sup> At the age of eight, he was baptized by a Salesian missionary priest, Domingo Mil-

anesio.<sup>[3]</sup> Namuncurá's early years were spent by the Río Negro river, and it was here that he, according to legend, miraculously survived a fall into the river. On September 20, 1897, Ceferino went to study with the Salesians at the Colegio Pío IX, a technical academy in <u>Almagro</u>, <u>Buenos</u> Aires. <sup>[4]</sup> 1901, Carlos Gardel.
