Joseph Calasanz' Fr. Joseph Calasanz (1872-1936) was born at Azanuy. In 1886 he saw aged, ailing Don Bosco in Barcelona. He became a Salesian in 1890, a priest five years later. He was Fr. Philip Rinaldi's secretary during his provincialate in Spain and then became provincial himself in Peru-Bolivia. On his return to Spain, he became superior the Barcelona-Valencia Province. He was a great-hearted man and a prodigious worker, concerned always for the salvation of his confreres. He was seized, along with other Sale-

sians, while he was presiding in Valencia at the annual retreat. While being transported by the militia, he was executed on July 29, 1936, with a bullet to the head. Memorial of Blessed Joseph Calasanz is September 22.
