On Pentecost Sunday we should all be remembering that first Resurrection evening when Jesus “breathed on” His disciples “and said: ‘Receive the Holy Spirit’”. The breath of Jesus brought the Holy Spirit and peace where previously there was devastation, sadness, fear, and a lack of life and hope.

On the day of Pentecost, we read, “suddenly from up in the sky there came a noise like a strong, driving wind which was heard all through the house where they were seated. Tongues as of fire appeared, which parted and came to rest on each of them. All were filled with the Holy Spirit. They began to express themselves in foreign tongues and make bold proclamation as the Spirit prompted them.”

WHO IS DON BOSCO

John Melchior Bosco, SDB, popularly known as Don Bosco, was an Italian Catholic priest, educator, writer and saint of the 19th century. While working in Turin, where the population suffered many of the ill-effects of industrialization and urbanization, he dedicated his life to the betterment and education of street children, juvenile delinquents, and other disadvantaged youth. He developed teaching methods based on love rather than punishment, a method that became known as the Salesian Preventive System.
