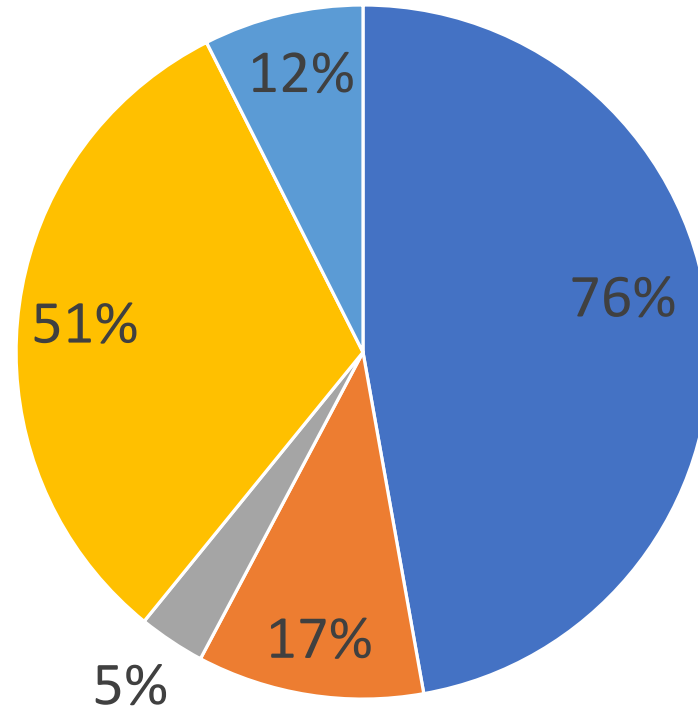
How many registered parishioners participated in the survey?

- 56 people completed the survey

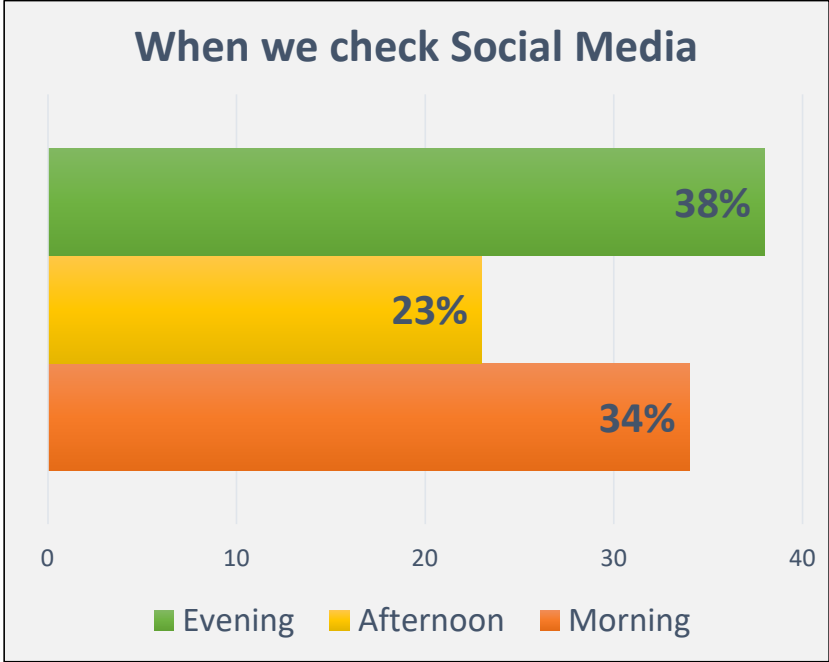
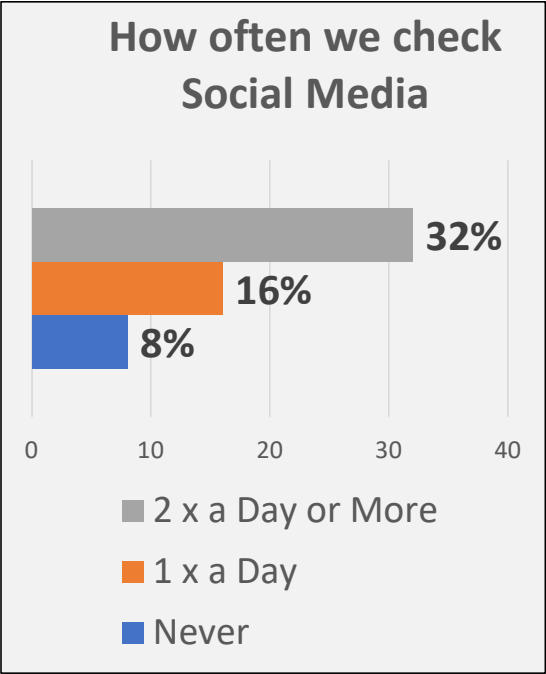
Our participation rate was about 23%

Frequency of Social Media Use



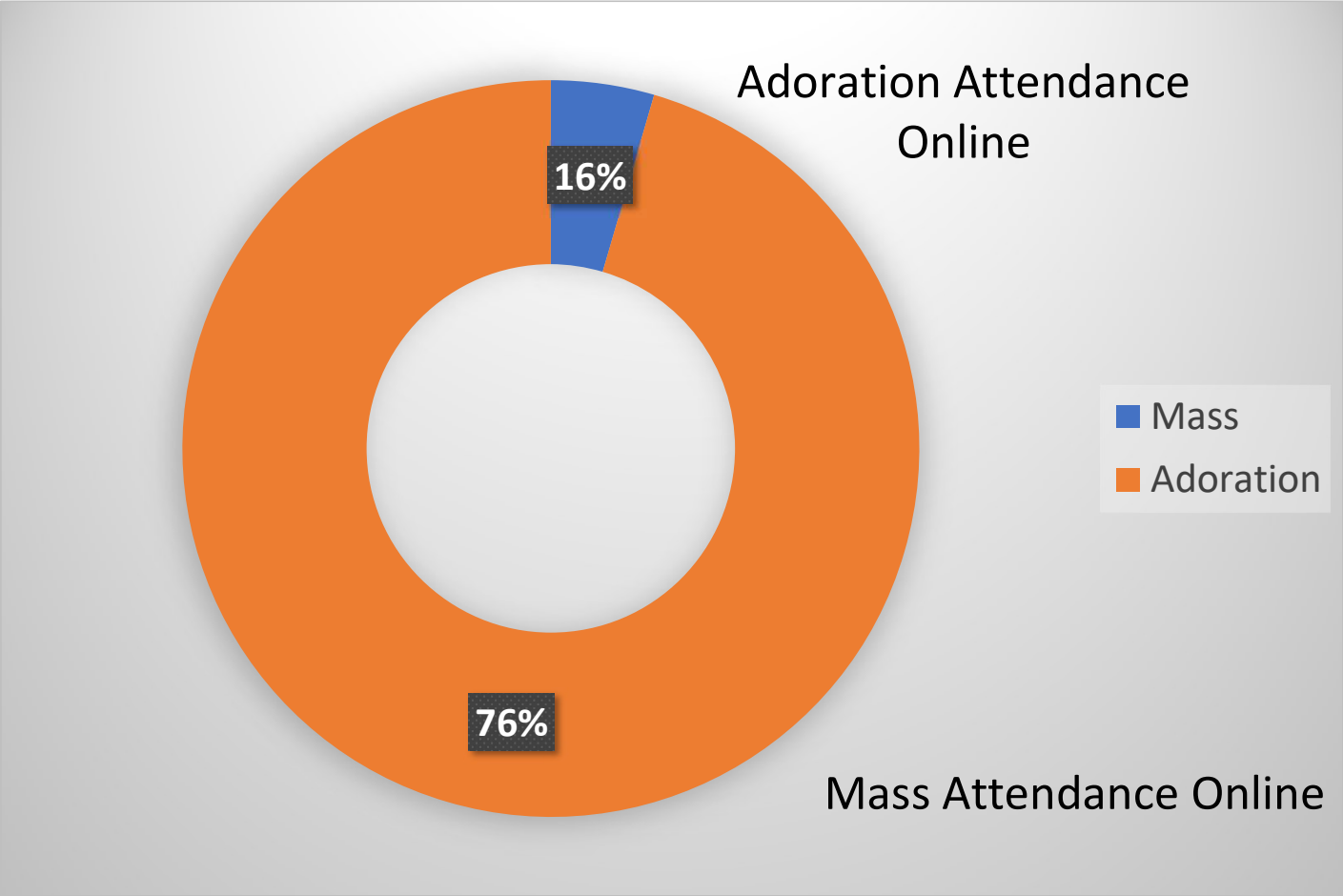
Bulletin Use

- The Ministries and Sacraments are hidden in the top left corner - I would think these are important and should be prominent.
